Annual Report 2023-24

Education of women plays a very important role in the overall development of the country. Keeping this in view, our founder president, His holiness Shrimanmaharaj Niranjan Jagadguru Dr. Gangadhar Rajayogeendra, Mahaswamiji of Moorusavirmath, Hubballi, established this esteemed college in the year 1967 to provide holistic education to women of different social spectra. Since then, till date, during the 56 years of its journey, the institution has excelled in academics, sports and cultural activities. The college has been through 3 cycles of NAAC assessment and has received 'A' grade during all cycles. We are also acknowledged with the status of College with Potential for Excellence (CPE) by UGC during the XI and XII plan period.

Being affiliated to Karnataka State Akkamahadevi Women's University Vijaypur, we are offering 2 UG programmes- BA and B.Com and 2 PG programmes-M.Com and M.A. Music respectively.

During the academic year 2023-24 a total of 575 students are pursuing the degree course and 51 students have enrolled for PG in Commerce and 12 students for PG in Hindustani Music. 16 social sciences and humanities and commerce subjects are being taught. 31 teaching and 16 non-teaching staff are rendering their valuable services to the institution. 09 teaching faculty are Ph.D holders.

The college has state of art and well equipped infrastructure facilities such as class rooms with LCD projectors, digital library, language lab, Psychology lab, Music lab, Computer lab, library, auditorium, Multi –Gym, canteen lift, RO drinking water facility hostel, in house health centre, Photocopiers, coloured printers CCTV and Wi-Fi, internet and intranet facility.

The office has been fully computerized with the installation of accounting and e-governance software packages.

The Library is equipped with bibliographic, OPAC facility, computerized attendance system, online journals on inflibnet concert, reprographic facility, audio visual facility. During the academic year we have procured a total of 950 books on various subjects, the library has 11 news papers, 25 magazines and more than 47,770 books.

More than 400 students have availed scholarship facility under NSP, SSP and Malabar Gold and Diamonds Hubli.

Co-curricular Activities.

The college aims to provide holistic education by organizing co-curricular activities like workshops, seminars, special lectures, field visits etc. The College has a placement cell collaborated with various popular institutions with vision to prepare students to face various competitive examinations and interviews in future.IQAC remained active in its attempts to enhance quality initiatives within the college. On 23rd Feb.2024 IQAC external committee meeting was held.

A workshop on Preparation for NAAC was organized on 19th Dec.2023. Prof. Aftab Spl. Officer JD office Dharwad was the resource person.

Department of English carried out an extension activity of teaching language skills to the 7th std students of shree Jagadguru Gangadhar High School from 11th Feb 2023 to 15th March 2024.

Department of Kannada in association with Rotary Club of Hubli,and Kannada Sahitya Parishat organize one day workshop on "Kannada Bashe" on 26thNov. 2023. 50 students of different colleges benefitted.

This year the **Department of Music** with the guidance of the SJMVS directors Shri Shashi Sali and Shri Mallikarjun Kalasaray initiated the Swaranjali-a monthly music programme to provide a platform to the music artists to showcase their talent. The first program was on 21st July 2023. So far we had 10 episodes of Swaranjali in which musicians have given their vocal and instrumental music performances.
